






























### Overview

- Social Work, for us, is about designing, strategizing and implementing the most effective solutions to all the societal problems we can identify.








### **Educational Outreach**


#### 50 Volunteers | 3 NGOs | 800+ potential IITians in the making

- The Dhruva initiative prepares more than 1000 students in grades 9-12 for exams like JEE, NEET, NTSE, and Olympiads through partnerships with NGOs Vriksh, Isha Vidya, and UCatapult.
- With a dedicated team of 50 volunteers, the program thrives in its mission to foster community empowerment.

### Ummeed

#### 35 Volunteers | 7 Hostels | A ray of hope for 50+ kids of staff

- Ummeed has continued to supplement the educational needs of the children of non-academic staff of IIT Bombay studying from classes 3rd-12th.
- The program offered classes in both offline and online formats, based on student preferences. This semester, more than 35 volunteers have helped conduct sessions for over 50 students.







## Adult Literacy Program

10+ Volunteers | 50+ Happy Learners

The Adult Literacy Program (ALP) provides educational support to over 35 non-academic staff, covering subjects such as English, Mathematics, Waste Management, and Computer Literacy. The initiative includes mess workers, housekeepers, EV drivers and security guards.

## Prayog

#### 10 Volunteers | 3 NGOs | 200+ students enjoying science

The Prayog initiative, organized by NSS IIT Bombay, focuses on enhancing science education for students from classes 7 to 10 through interactive experiment demonstrations. Through Prayog, volunteers aim to make Science more engaging and accessible, fostering curiosity and learning among students.





### Muskaan & Neem School

#### 20+ Volunteers | 3 NGOs | 400+ children developing skills

- The Muskaan and Neem initiative comprises two parts: Muskaan, which fosters cultural skills in children, and Neem School, which offers moral education through interactive methods.
- It currently operates in three NGOs: Asha, LCCWA, and Vidya, serving students from grades 1 to 10, and impacting more than 400 students.

### Kendriya Vidyalaya Sessions

15+ Volunteers | 450+ learners inspired by science

The KV Initiative aims to inspire scientific curiosity and hands-on learning among students in grades 6 to 8 at Kendriya Vidyalaya, located in the IIT Bombay campus.

- This year Abhinay introduced a new genre: Dramatics aimed at nurturing the acting and expressive abilities of underprivileged children.
- Children from NGOs across Mumbai engaged in a friendly inter-NGO duel in art, poetry, quizzing, dance, and singing held at IIT Bombay, with an aim to provide a stage for the underprivileged to showcase their talents.

200+ students | Along with Mars Rover Team, IIT Bombay



Engaging over 90 students, the session combined informative handouts on climate change, synthetic biology, carbon footprint, and capture techniques with fun word games—making learning about sustainability both educational and enjoyable.

Throughout the semester, the Educational Outreach Department of NSS, IIT Bombay compiled a comprehensive database detailing scholarships, financial assistance, and job opportunities offered by the Central and State Governments, companies like Tata Group, NGOs, and others for individuals who overcame challenges to pursue education in adulthood. In total, our repository comprised almost 25 such scholarships.

This repository, along with the study materials such as question banks, detailed chapter-wise notes, and revision sheets for subjects like Mathematics, Mental Ability, Reasoning, and English—key for various government exams—will be uploaded to the Educational Outreach website of NSS IIT Bombay next semester. These materials have been prepared by NSS volunteers over the years.

# Cloth Collection & Graduation Collection


10 tonnes of donation collected | 5000+ end beneficiaries

40+ Students | Little Sisters of the Poor old-age home


- A heartwarming visit where enthusiastic students spent quality time with the elderly residents.

# Republic day Visit


